Re: Accessibility Apps

Following the June 19th AAC meeting members discussed the option to promote certain accessibility apps. Based on initial research there are two identified apps that address the needs highlighted by members:

- 1- Access Now
- 2- WheelMap

Both Access Now and WheelMap use maps to identify barrier-free locations as well as those that have barriers. The idea is that users would update information and that businesses would make an effort to go from "red – barriers" to "green – no barriers". Based on initial review and testing of the apps, WheelMap appears to be more user friendly and easier to navigate.

The Committee may wish to select one app to update information about accessible locations/businesses in the municipality. In both apps, there is very limited information about accessible places in Mississippi Mills.

Re: 5 year Accessibility Plan - Outline

The AODA requires that any municipality with a population of 10,000 or greater have an Accessibility Advisory Committee as well as develop annual and multi-year plans. The existing 2015-2019 is coming to an end and a new multi-year plan needs to be adopted by Council prior to 2020.

The following is a proposed outline for the 2020-2025 plan:

1. Introduction

- a. About Mississippi Mills outline demographics, population, Council makeup, etc.
- Relevant Legislation brief summary of AODA requirements,
 Integrated Accessibility Standards Regulation, Ontario Building Code.
- c. About the Accessibility Advisory Committee mandate of the committee, what they do, membership, etc.

2. Key Focus Areas:

There are five key areas that have clear AODA requirements:

- a. Customer Service
- b. Information and Communications
- c. Employment
- d. Transportation
- e. Public Spaces

This section will touch on what the municipality has done and goals for the 2020-2025 plan. It will be organized by key area.

The only area that does not fully apply to Mississippi Mills is transportation as Mississippi Mills does not have a transit system (ex. OC Transpo). Most

of the AODA requirements relate to the operation of public transportation systems.

3. Accessibility Moving Forward

In this section we can highlight areas outside of the AODA mandate that the municipality may wish to action. Some examples could be:

- Accessibility survey (ask the public for feedback on plan and identify issues and barriers)
- Identify groups in Mississippi Mills or neighbouring AACs to promote accessibility in the area
- Creating an accessibility fund- the AAC would identify accessibility projects to Council on an annual basis for approval, this could be installing automatic door openers at municipal buildings, adding accessible features to parks, reducing barriers identified in the annual report.
