

Mississippi Mills: By-Laws 101

Issue 2: Parking/Storage of Recreation Vehicles Zoning By-law, Section 8.17

This week we are featuring section 8.14 of the Zoning By-law (By-law 11-83) which regulates **outdoor parking/ storage of recreation vehicles** in residential areas.

Quick facts:

- In residential zones, a recreation vehicle may only be stored/parked if it does not exceed the following:
 - 1 boat 8.5m (27.9 feet) in length
 - 1 tourist vehicle 8.5m (27.9 feet) in length
 - 2 snowmobiles
 - 1 tourist trailer 8.5m (27.9 feet) in length
- The parking/outside storage of a recreation vehicle is not permitted for a period of more than 72 hours in any one calendar month in a front or exterior side yard (yard that abuts a street).
- If you wish to park/store a recreation vehicle on your property for longer than 72 hours you may do so if it is parked in your side or rear yard.
- Recreation vehicles cannot be used for living or sleeping accommodation for more than 30 consecutive days.
- A recreation vehicle may not be leased or rented for accommodation while stored/parked on a residential lot.
