

Mississippi Mills: By-Laws 101

Issue 5: Waste Management

As part of a public education series, the Municipality of Mississippi Mills will be publishing quick facts about questions commonly asked regarding by-laws and policies.

This week we are featuring **Waste Management and Collection** (By-law 14-33) which contains information regarding **garbage and recycling** within Mississippi Mills.

Quick facts:

- Items to be picked up may be placed out after 6:00 pm the day before collection, but must be placed out no later than 7:00 am on the designated collection day. All empty containers must be removed by the occupant by 9:00 pm on the day of collection.
- Each rate payer shall be permitted to set out one (1) acceptable container of waste per week. No bag tag is required for the first container. Each additional container or bag set out shall have a bag tag affixed to it. Bag tags can be purchased at the Municipal Office reception desk at 3131 Old Perth Road, Almonte for \$2 a tag.
- Two landfill passes will be mailed to all home owners in August. Each pass is valid
 for one free load up to 250kg at the Beckwith Transfer Station. Free Landfill passes
 will expire on December 31 of the following year. Hazardous waste will not be
 accepted.
- Large items will not be collected curbside. The Beckwith Transfer Station accepts waste not collected curbside and your landfill pass can be redeemed there.
- Property owners are strongly discouraged from disposing of household organic items in the curbside waste collection. The Municipality has backyard composters available for residents to purchase.
- Recyclable materials are sorted into a dual stream system. Fibres, including paper and cardboard shall be placed in your Blue Bin. Containers, including glass, plastic, metal, gable top and tetra packs shall be placed in your Yellow Bin. Fibers are collected one week and Containers the following week. Please check our website and sign up with our Recycle Coach App to receive notifications.
