Issue 8: Animal Control By-law

This issue features the **Animal Control By-law** (By-law 14-21) which contains information regarding **licencing and registration, limitations on the number of pets, animals at large and nuisance** within Mississippi Mills. As summer weather is approaching please help sustain the community's clean and comfortable environment by keeping your dogs on leashes and cleaning up after them.

- When an animal is not within the limits of the owners' property, it must be either constrained by a leash, or under direct control of the owner or care taker.
- If a dog is deemed dangerous by the municipality, it must be under control of a person sixteen (16) years of age or older and under leash not to exceed two (2 m) metres in length and be muzzled as well.
- Be sure to pick up after your dog. The By-law requires that dog waste be removed from public property and be disposed of appropriately e.g. flush down the toilet.
